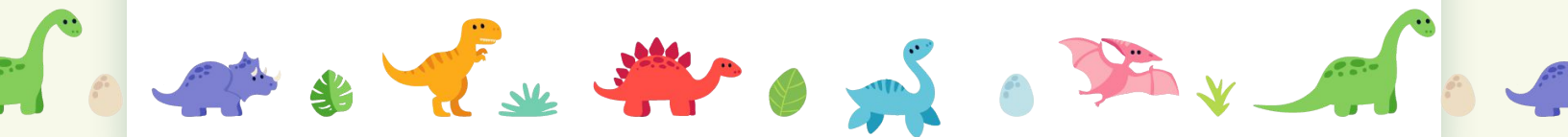
We have tried to be open and honest about who we are and what you can expect from us. But please know that you can ask us anything. We want you to be a part of our lives and look forward to learning about you as well.

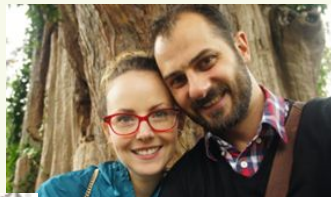
